

F/J Cooperation Opportunities in H2020 2016-2017

General principles for participation in H2020 collaborative research & innovation projects

- Must be carried out by consortia of organisations working together on specific research & innovation areas. A consortium must include at least 3 participants from 3 different EU Member States or Associated countries. In addition to these three partners, any legal entity from anywhere in the world can be included in the consortium.
- Researchers throughout the world can participate in Horizon 2020 projects though they are not always eligible for H2020 funding. In exceptional circumstances, industrialised and emerging economies can receive EU funding if:
 - ✓ there is a bilateral agreement between that country and the EU. For instance, researchers in the United States are eligible for EU funding when participating in the health programme on the basis of a reciprocal EU US/NIH arrangement
 - ✓ the country is explicitly identified in the relevant work programme and call for proposal as being eligible for funding
 - ✓ their participation is deemed by the European Commission to be essential for carrying out the action.
