CNRS Key-Figures



- National Research Center (headquarter in Paris).
- 33 000 employees.
- 1025 laboratories.
- 21 Nobel Prize laureates, 12 Fields Medal laureates.

GDR: Research Groupment

- GDR is a (scientific) networking tool provided by CNRS.
- Virtual research structure (no dedicated building) that focuses on a given topic (e.g., computer security or artificial intelligence).
- Currently: 183 GDRs in France.
- Collaborative structure: any researcher can participate, not only CNRS-affiliated ones.
- No exclusivity: a researcher can belong to several GDRs.
- Animate and coordinate the French scientific community: meetings, workshops, etc.

Training School for Young Researchers



- Train PhD students and PostDocs already involved in computer security.
- One-week event. The location changes.
- Covers any security topic.
- Registration fees are low.

REDOCS

- Boot camp between professionals and Phd Students.
- Last-year PhD students are targeted.
- Make students collaborating, discovering off-road topics,....
- Access to students who will be soon on the job market.





Society-oriented Colloquium

- Top-level researchers were challenged with security questions.
- A book is likely to be published in 2018.

- PhD students and Postdocs are put forward.
- Collaboration are launched.
