The *Inria@SiliconValley* team is very happy to present you this **monthly newsletter**, a new tool to share with you the latest news about the program, highlighting in particular the collaborations that are starting and strengthening in 2015.

Inria@SiliconValley is now in its 5th year, accompanying collaborations between Inria researchers and colleagues from California. In 2015, **4 new associated teams** have been created for a period of 3 years and **2 have been renewed**.



In total, we have currently **15 associate teams** between Inria and Californian teams, together with **4 Inria International Chair positions** held by Professors and researchers of Californian universities and laboratories. In addition, fruitful collaboration on the **smart city topic keeps ongoing with CITRIS colleagues**, with a special focus on promoting citizen engagement.

This month, among other news, we are glad to advertise the opening of a **Post-Doc position** to support research collaboration between Inria and Californian teams. Deadline for application is March 15th.

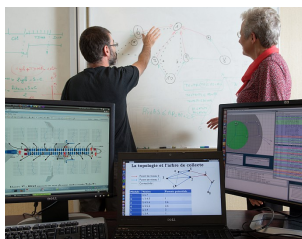

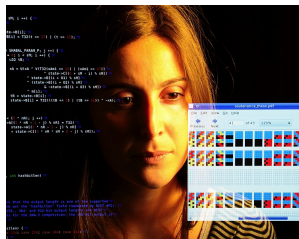
