

Objectives

- To strengthen and structure existing collaborations between Inria research teams and Californian universities in order to improve their visibility and impact.
- To create and support new innovative projects with complementary competences, addressing scientific challenges of the digital society.

Resources

- Funding collaborative research within joint projects
- A post-doc program
- Exchanges of visits of junior and senior researchers, faculty members, and graduate students
- Joint workshops : an annual Berkeley Inria Stanford (BIS) workshop alternatively in California and in France.




Joint research projects : Inria Associate Teams program C



- Annual call for joint research project between an Inria project-team and an American research team abroad (in July with deadline in September)
- Supports scientific activities for 3 years
- 30-50 K€ funding per project



15 On-going joint projects in 2016





Exchanges programs

Inria Internships program for Masters or PhD students

- A 2 to 6 month visit in an Inria team
- Financial support to help with living expenses in France.
- Possible grants from NSF or French Embassy

Post-doctoral positions

- 1-5 post-doctoral positions dedicated to Inria@SiliconValley each year
- 20 Inria@SiliconValley post-doctoral fellows since 2011

Inria International Chairs

- Long visits (12 months over 5 years) of world-class researchers at Inria research teams
- 4 Chair holders from Californian Institution since 2013

Sabbatical visits

- Inria Senior scientists from spending 6 to 12 months in a California research Team
- 7 sabbatical visits since 2011
- An Inria senior researcher in charge of animating and coordinating the program

Junior scientist short visits

 since 2011 : 3 Junior scientists from Inria spent 1 to 3 months in a California research Team
