Program launched in 2011 by Inria in cooperation with CITRIS

- MOU between CITRIS and Inria [2010-2015]
- Formal hosting by CITRIS since 2016

Stated Objectives since Creation

- Strengthen and structure existing collaborations between Inria research teams and California universities to improve their visibility and impact.
- Create and support new innovative projects with complementary competences, addressing scientific challenges of the digital society.

Supporting Inria Programs & Resources

- Funding collaborative research projects within the Associated teams annual call
- An Inria senior researcher as scientific coordinator based full-time in California
- A Post-doc program
- Exchanges of visits of junior and senior researchers, faculty members, and graduate students
- Joint workshops : Annual *Inria@SIliconValley* workshop (BIS) alternatively in California and in France.




Joint research projects : Inria Associate Teams program (2017)



- Annual call for joint research project between an Inria project-team and a research team abroad (open in July with deadline in September)
- Supports scientific activities for 3 years (renewable once for 3 more years)
- 30-50K€ total funding per project
- Since 2016, possibility to couple with CITRIS seed funding

Exchange Programs (2017)

Inria Internships program for Masters or PhD students

- A 2 to 6 month visit in an Inria team
- Stipend to contribute to living expenses in France.
- Possible grants from the French Embassy (Chateaubriand Fellowship Program in partnership with Inria)

Post-doctoral positions

- 1-5 post-doctoral positions dedicated to Inria@SiliconValley each year
- 22 Inria@SiliconValley post-doctoral fellows since 2011
- 1 in 2015-16, 2 in 2016-17

Inria International Chairs

- Long visits (12 months over 5 years) of world-class researchers at Inria research teams
- 5 Chair holders from California Institution since 2013





Exchange Programs (2017)

Sabbatical visits

- Inria Senior scientists from spending 6 to 12 months in a California research Team
- 7 sabbatical visits since 2011
- An Inria senior researcher in charge of animating and coordinating the program

Junior scientist short visits

• Since 2011 : 3 Junior scientists from Inria spent 1 to 3 months in a California research Team


