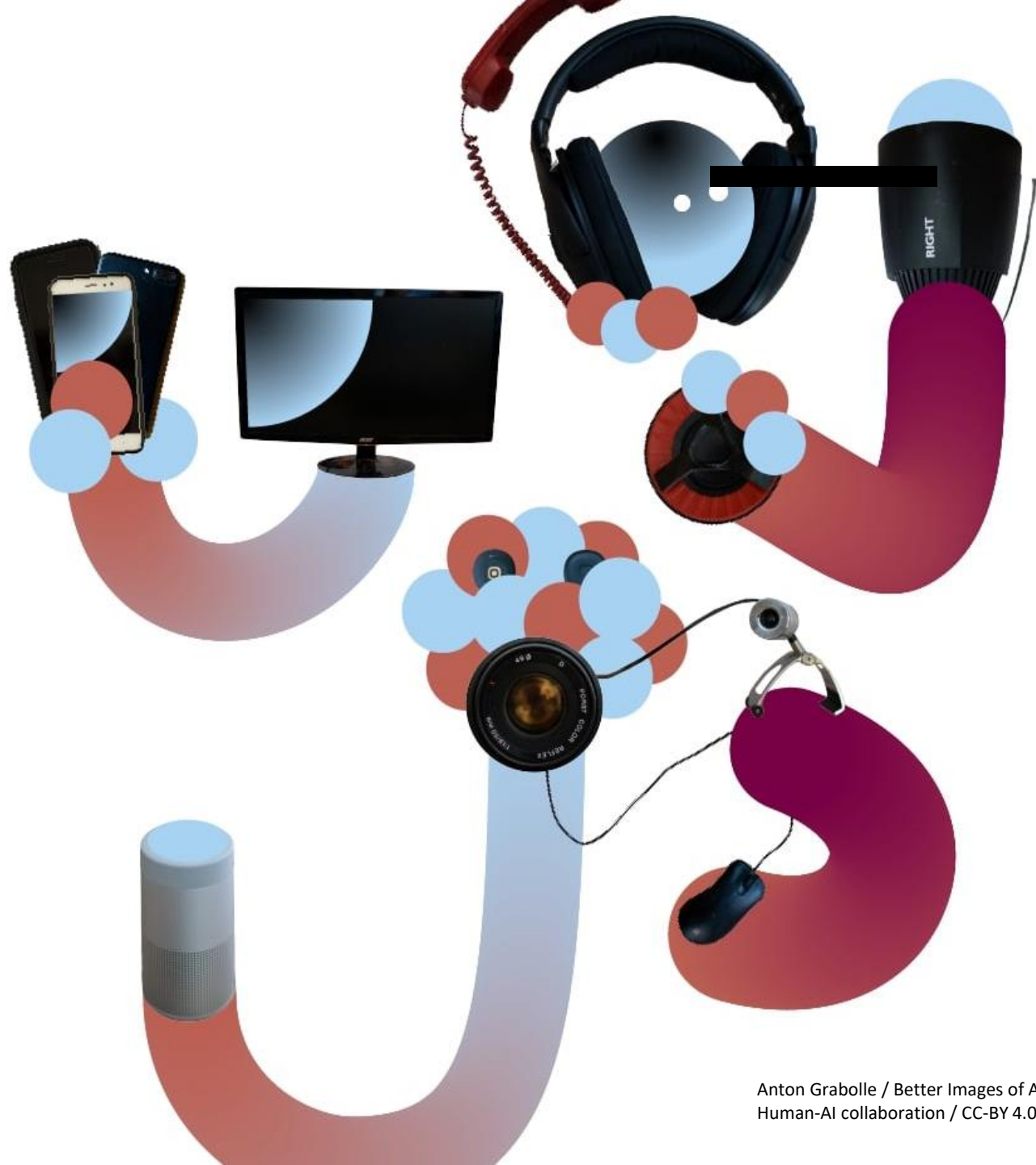

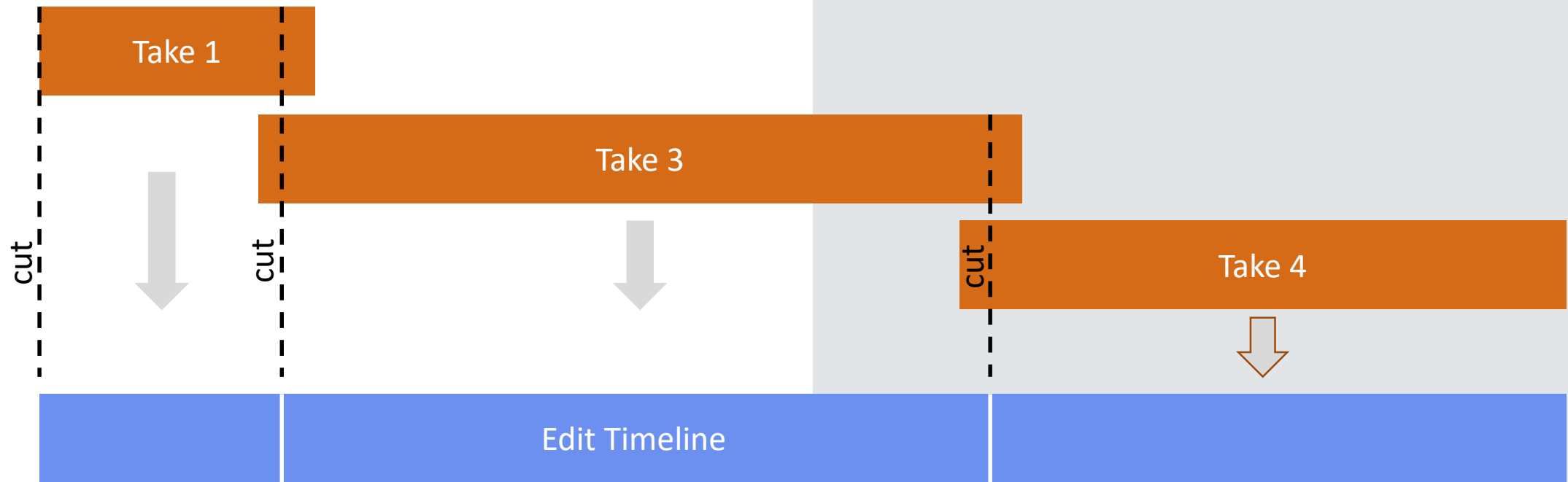

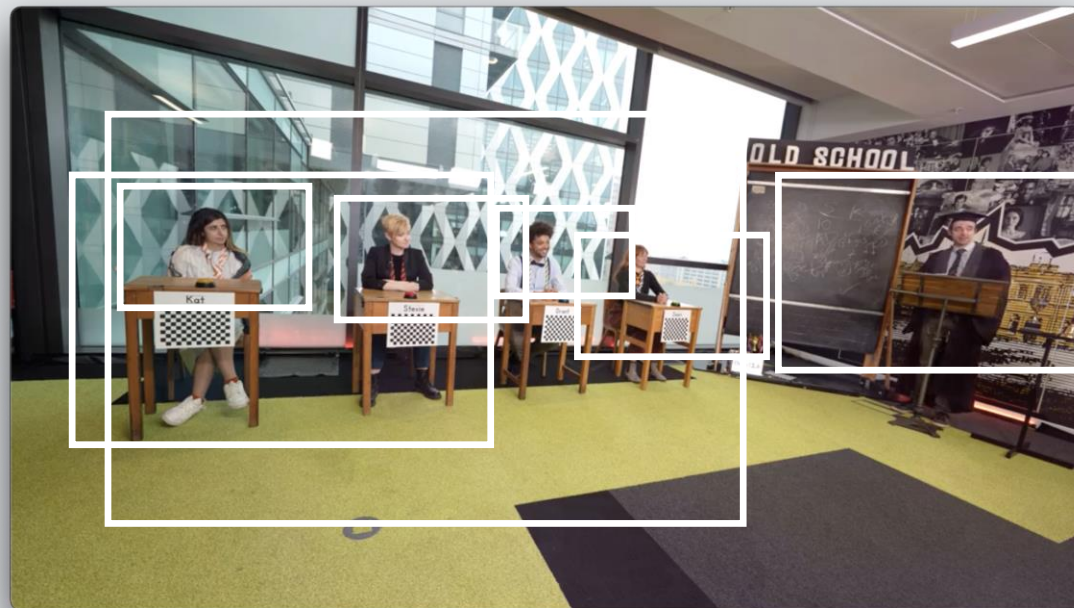

# 1. Create Edit Timeline



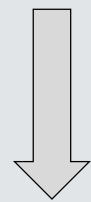
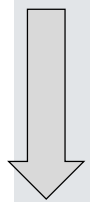
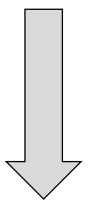

# Tasks for the WICED Competition

3. Cut between shots at suitable times



# Rules

- Submit a video edit using material from Part 2 of the Old School script. (Deadline January 2024, TBC)
- Results announced at WICED 2024
- Entrants are encouraged to submit a paper to WICED 2024 describing their methods
- Use the example edit timeline from the dataset\*

\*unless you are automating the generation of such a timeline, but you probably don't want to do that to start with





# Evaluation – Creative Track

Judged by a panel of media experts, scoring entries on:

- Relevance of the shots chosen
- Variety of the shots used
- Artistry of the creative decisions taken



# Evaluation – Technical Track

Entries can either:

- attempt to produce a complete edit, or
- focus on a single aspect of automated editing, such as framing.

Judged by a panel of media and research experts according to how much each entry advances the state of the art in Intelligent Cinematography and Editing.
