Registration

Registration will take place in the main entrance of Inria Building

- from 9:00 a.m. on Monday December 4 for the tutorials
- from 6:00 p.m. on Monday December 4 (during the Wine and Cheese party) and on Tuesday December 5 from 8:00 a.m. for the main conference.



There will be a security checkpoint at the entrance of the Inria Building. All the participants will be invited to present their ID or passport.

The secretariat will be available during the whole conference.

SHUTTLES « WIFS 2017 » (recommended means of transportation)

Free shuttles (autocars Keolis) have been scheduled by the organization staff between Rennes downtown (Place de la République) and the conference place.

From « Place de la République » bus stop (see map) to conference (morning and evening)

The meeting point for the shuttle is "Place de la République", in front of the "Brasserie de la Paix" restaurant.

Public transport

To get to campus de Beaulieu with public transportation, take the local bus from the STAR company (STAR bus ticket unit price: 1.50 € - Validity: 1h.)

The closest bus stop to the campus de Beaulieu is "Tournebride" on lines C4, 6, and 41. Then walk from "Tournebride" bus stop in the campus de Beaulieu to find Inria Rennes, 5 minute walk (See map in satellite view, « IEEE WIFS » signs will show you the way).

From Rennes downtown

The central bus stop downtown is called "Place de la République". Take bus lines 6 (direction "Cesson-Sévigné - Rigourdière"), or C4 (direction "ZA Saint-Sulpice") and get off at "Tournebride" station. It takes about 15 minutes to reach the campus de Beaulieu from downtown. Bus lines C4 and 6 are regular lines; they are running every 10mn all day long.

From Rennes train station

One option is to take the subway towards "J.F. Kennedy" and to get off at "Place de la République" station. Then take the bus lines C4 or 6 (as above).

Another option in the morning is to take **express line 41** driving from the railway station to the campus.

♣ From Rennes St-Jacques airport

We highly recommend taking a taxi. It takes around 20 minutes to reach downtown or campus de Beaulieu. The fare is around 20€.

Otherwise, walk 500 meters under the rain from the airport to bus stops "Pommerais" or "Abbé Grimault". Take the rare bus line 57 to Rennes city center. Get off at "Place de la Republique" to take bus lines C4 or 6.

Internet access

Wireless Internet access is available on the site. Your personal wifi login will be given to you on the first day, with your registration kit.

Catering

Coffee breaks: coffee/tea/pastries/fruit will be served during morning and afternoon breaks. There will be no coffee served before morning sessions.

Lunches: They will be served on site.

Dinners: Those are at your own convenience. Rennes has a lot of nice restaurants and places to eat that you will discover during your stay.

Social events

All participants are kindly requested to wear their badges to attend the social events. Reminder: registration is mandatory.

- A "Cheese & Wine" cocktail is organized on Monday 4 from 18:00 at Inria Rennes (main entrance) for all the participants. A bus shuttle service will be provided (for free) from the Conference venue to downtown.
- A reception at the City Hall is organized on Tuesday 5 from 19:00 for all the participants and accompanying persons. A bus shuttle service will be provided (for free) from the Conference venue to the City Hall.
- ♣ An excursion to Le Mont St-Michel followed by the Conference dinner is organized for registered participants on Wednesday 6 afternoon. Buses will depart from the conference venue at 2:00 PM. Please make sure to be on time!
